Job Title: Field Technician - Understory Crew Member (2 positions)

Understory Crew Members will help carry out research on the effects of silvicultural treatments on the ecology of managed forests as part of the Hardwood Ecosystem Experiment (HEE) near Bloomington, IN. The primary duty of these positions will be to conduct understory surveys measuring and identifying herbaceous and woody plants inside and outside deer exclosures. Understory crew members may also be asked to assist with forest insect and moth surveys at certain times during the field season.

## Qualifications:

### Required

- Bachelor's degree in botany, forestry, or related natural resources field
- Strong plant identification skills
- Valid driver's license with a good driving record
- Willingness to work in extreme conditions, including traversing rugged terrain through dense, thorny shrubs and working in high temperatures and high humidity

### Preferred

- Experience with herbaceous and woody vegetation identification in the Midwest
- Experience with hand-held GPS units, maps and compass

Each work week will generally consist of five 8-hour days in summer months. Work will not exceed 40 hours in a week. Recent B.S. graduates are encouraged to apply; *start and end dates are somewhat flexible depending on individual's schedules*.
